

## **Grooming Instructions**



These pictures are good references for the shape of the head. Always try to leave more hair on the head and face since it grows slower than the rest of the body.

- 1. Top of the head should round off to the ears but be long and flowing, kind of bouncy.
- 2. Outside the eyes should be long. These are part of the eyebrow and need to be as long as the picture shows. Eyelashes should be approx. 1.5 inches long.
- 3. Muzzle should be cut vertically. No horizontal lines should be evident. The entire muzzle should have a round shape if you are looking straight at it.
- 4. Chin should be rounded at the bottom and be as long as you prefer.
- 5. Ears should be cut to the leathers and layered long and natural looking. Hair inside ears should be plucked or trimmed to promote airflow.
- 6. Fur on the inside of the eyes should be trimmed short but also have a natural look to keep hair out of eyes.
- 7. The top muzzle and forehead (stop) should NOT be shaved and only be lightly trimmed to look natural and not choppy.
- 8. Legs should be cut to look like a column so that the foot is not seen. The fur on the legs may be longer than the rest of the body to create this appearance. This type of cut is called a "Lamb Trim."
